

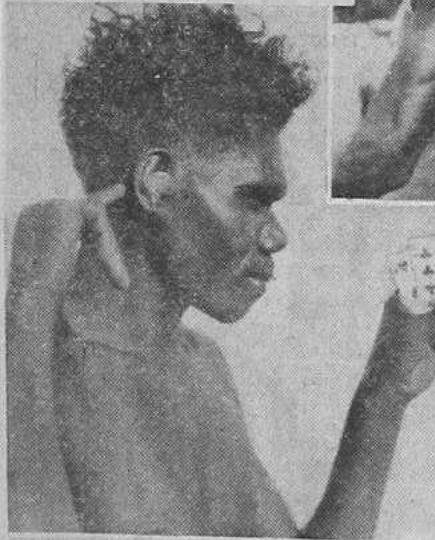

## THE SEARCH FOR NEMARLUCK



SPECIAL PICTURES from The Herald's representative in Darwin taken during the search for Namarluck, the notorious Fitzmaurice River aboriginal goalkicker. Top (left), Moses, a Port Essington native, teaching two little tribal brothers some corroboree steps; (right), Paddy, a black tracker, holding the singlet worn by Conscience Don's black tracker, who shot Namarluck at Delosaville Island in a hand-to-hand encounter on October 17. The singlet was torn by Namarluck's spear, and Smiler's back was grazed in the fight. Above, a house boy at the aboriginal compound who keeps his money in his ear rather than lose by piling it in the dirt while playing poker. Right, a close-up of "Smiler" after his fight with Namarluck.
