BRISBANE. - White radicals were financing and manipulating militant aboriginals to their own ends. the sole aboriginal in the Federal Government Senator Bonner, said at the weekend.

He said that no more than six aboriginals in Australia were "well and truly on the Black Power bandwagon."

"As I see it, we have radical, Left-Wing, miliwhite people who want to take the law into their own hands. Senator Bonner said.
